Illinois State Police Announce Results of Roadside Safety Check in DuPage County

Downers Grove, IL – The Illinois State Police (ISP) announced the results of a Roadside Safety Check (RSC) held in DuPage County during the late evening hours of Saturday, June 19, 2021, and early morning hours of Sunday, June 20, 2021. The detail was conducted on the northbound Veterans Memorial Tollway (I-355) on the ramp to Butterfield Road in Downers Grove by ISP District 15 officers.

Alcohol is involved in nearly 40 percent of fatal crashes in Illinois. RSCs are designed to remove alcohol-impaired drivers. However, when other violations are observed such as driving with a suspended or revoked license, operating a vehicle without a valid registration or insurance or safety belt violations, enforcement action may be taken. The following enforcement action was issued at the safety check:
