Illinois State Police Announce Results of Distracted Driving Enforcement Patrols in Cook, DuPage, Kane and Lake Counties

Downers Grove, IL – Illinois State Police District 15 Commander Jason Bradley announced today enforcement figures for Distracted Driving Enforcement Patrols (DDEP) conducted November 16 and November 23 on the Tri-State Tollway (I-94/I-294) in Cook and Lake counties and the Reagan Memorial Tollway (I-88) in DuPage and Kane counties.
