Scope: As part of the Tollway's Central Tri-State project, the Tollway is constructing a fire suppression system along the Mile Long Bridge ("Project"). The Tollway has identified certain benefits and potential cost savings that would be realized by constructing a water system interconnect between the existing 36-inch diameter watermain, which is owned and operated by the Village, and the existing 20-inch diameter watermain, which is owned and operated by the Commission. The Tollway has agreed to add the interconnect construction to its Project, subject to reimbursement of 50% of the actual costs by the Village and the Commission.
