Resolution No. 19480, adopted on August 25, 2011, and Resolution No. 19498, adopted on September 29, 2011, affirmed the basis for calculating annual CV toll rate adjustments set forth in Resolution No. 18516. The following table shows the rate adjustments made since 2018 as well as the rate adjustment scheduled to take effect on January 1, 2023.

January 1,	2018	2019	2020	2021	2022	Scheduled 2023
CV rate increase	1.839%	2.254%	2.072%	1.564%	2.302%	7.173%

At and after the above-described method of calculating annual CV toll rate adjustments was approved, Tollway revenue projections assumed an annual CV toll rate increase of 2%, which was based on the Tollway Traffic Engineers' estimation of an annual inflation rate of 2% for years during and after 2018. As shown above, the assumption was accurate for 2018 - 2022. However, in 2023, the rate of inflation significantly deviated from the recent past.

To reduce volatility in annual CV toll rate adjustments, staff is recommending that the method of calculating annual CV toll rate adjustments be revised. Instead of basing adjustments on the percentage change in the CPI-U over the 12 months ended June 30th of the prior year, adjustments should be based on the annualized percentage change in the CPI-U, or its successor index, over the 36 months ended June 30th of the prior year. In addition to reducing volatility, the requested revision will increase near-term predictability of CV toll revenues, facilitating Tollway financial planning and budgeting.

Using the revised method of calculating annual CV toll rate adjustments, the 7.173% annual CV toll rate adjustment scheduled to take effect January 1, 2023 will instead be 3.650%. After 2023, the revised calculation method is not expected to materially change total commercial vehicle toll revenues over any 3+ year period.

As set forth in Section 713, subsection 4 of the Tollway's Trust Indenture, the requested revision to the method of calculating annual CV toll rate adjustments is subject to certain notices, certifications and estimates, which will be obtained prior to utilization of the revised calculation method.

## Revised Method of Calculating Annual Commercial Vehicle Toll Rate Adjustment

Amount: As a result of the changed methodology, 2023 CV toll rates will increase by 3.650% instead of the currently scheduled 7.173%. The impact on future CV toll rates will be dependent on future changes in CPI-U. Cumulative adjustments to CV toll rates resulting from the changed methodology are not expected to exceed cumulative adjustments that would have occurred under the current methodology.

### **Order Against DoIT Master Contract**

**Contract #:** 22-0118

Description: CallWorks CallStation Hardware, Software, Installation, and Support Services

Scope: This procurement, which will be against a master contract, provides for the upgrade of the Tollway's public safety call handling infrastructure. The project includes the purchase and installation of new hardware and software plus three years of maintenance and support for the Tollway's Dispatch Operations Center. The hardware and software are needed to ensure that emergency and non-emergency calls are effectively managed and appropriately recorded per industry standards. Such standards include the State's Next Generation 911 (NG911) requirements and ADA best practices along with Phase 1 (Land Line) and Phase 2 (Cellular) compliance related to location tracking across multiple local, regional, state and national public safety jurisdictions. The upgrade also will allow our Dispatch Center to accept text messages, which will be required by law as of January 1, 2023.

The required hardware and software, which will cost \$2,474,131.16, must be purchased before the master contract expires on September 28, 2022. If the master contract is extended, as currently anticipated, the Tollway also will purchase installation services, which will cost \$557,399.88 and will have to be completed prior to March 27, 2023, the anticipated expiration date of the extended contract.

Amount: The upgrade, including hardware, software, maintenance, support and installation, will cost \$3,031,531.04.

#### **Company Information**
