ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ANNOUNCE RESULTS OF ALCOHOL COUNTERMEASURE ENFORCEMENT PATROLS IN COOK, DUPAGE AND KANE COUNTIES

DOWNERS GROVE – Illinois State Police (ISP) District 15 Commander Jason Bradley announces the results of Alcohol Countermeasure Enforcement (ACE) patrols on the Reagan Memorial Tollway (I-88) in Kane and DuPage counties and the Tri-State Tollway (I-294) in Cook County during the month of April. These ACE patrols allowed the ISP to focus on preventing, detecting and taking enforcement action in response to violations associated with impaired driving and illegal transportation or consumption of alcohol or drugs.
