### **ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ANNOUNCE ROADSIDE SAFETY CHECK RESULTS IN KANE COUNTY**

DOWNERS GROVE – Illinois State Police (ISP) District 15 Commander Jason Bradley announces the results of a Roadside Safety Check (RSC) held in Kane County from late night Saturday, June 25, 2022, to early morning Sunday, June 26, 2022. The RSC was conducted on the Reagan Memorial Tollway (I-88) eastbound at the Illinois Route 31 Toll Plaza in Aurora by District 15 officers.
