### **ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ANNOUNCE RESULTS OF NIGHTTIME ENFORCEMENT PATROLS**

DOWNERS GROVE – Illinois State Police (ISP) District 15 Commander Jason Bradley announces the results of Nighttime Enforcement (NITE) patrols in Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake and Will counties during the month of June. These NITE patrols allowed the ISP to focus on preventing, detecting and taking enforcement action in response to impaired driving and occupant restraint violations especially between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
