
## **A-36 TOLLWAY LOCATING PROCEDURE**

- The Illinois Tollway <u>DOES NOT PARTICIPATE</u> in the J.U.L.I.E. one call system.
- If you are working on the Tollway or near the ramps, you MUST use the online A-36 system to request locating for your digging project.
- You must have a valid Contract or Permit to enter a request for an A-36-locate.
- Prepare a plan sheet specific to the area showing the location of the work area represented by <u>tollway mile markers only</u>. (match line / station #'s are not acceptable)
- Mark the location in the field with stakes and or paint (WHITE) only.
- Maximum locating distance for each A-36 is <u>one (1) mile and in one (1) direction.</u>
- Tollway facilities must be located and marked before any underground work is started on Tollway property. Requests are accepted online only at (www.illinoisvirtualtollway.com/DoingBusiness.aspx) follow the necessary links

## • TOLERANCE ZONE:

The Tolerance Zone is defined as an area at least 4 feet wide and cannot be wider than the width of the underground facilities plus 24" on each side (4-feet total). In addition to establishing the approximate location of the Illinois Tollway facilities, if underground operations are contemplated within the Tolerance Zone of the location marked or flagged in the field, the Contractor must expose the fiber optic cable to verify its horizontal and vertical location. Excavation within the <u>Tolerance Zone</u> – requires, extra care and precaution. It is <u>mandatory the contractor hydrovac and/or hand</u> <u>dig to expose Tollway Facilities that are located within the Tolerance Zone.</u> There must be a 360 degree view of the facilities and/or cable.
