



Engineering 2024 Co-Op Program

The Illinois Tollway 2024 Engineering Cooperative Education (Co-Op) Program is designed to enhance students' academic curriculum through fieldwork experience on active construction projects*. This program aligns with the Engineering Department's mission of ensuring safety and efficiency of roadway construction and maintenance. Under the guidance of an Illinois Tollway engineer, students will be exposed to a year-round experience of engineering work arranged in three phases:

- Planning (Forecasting and project management)
- Design (Structural drafting and 3-D modeling)
- Construction (Inspections and traffic maintenance)

Embedded within technical learning and skill application will be soft skills trainings such as presentation skills, professional communication and other core competencies for engineering professionals.

The Engineering Co-Op Program is ideal for current students who are interested in Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Construction Management, Industrial Engineering and related fields.

Interns can anticipate a paid part-time experience requiring 30 hours per week during the summer and reduced part-time hours (15 hours per week) during the fall and spring semesters.

Please note: Students must have reliable transportation to active construction sites which may, or may not, be easily accessible by public transportation.
